**Ability Commerce Releases Ability Financials™ Release 10.0**

Delray Beach, FL, February 26, 2008 – Ability Commerce releases Ability Financials Release 10.0 with seven customer-requested enhancements.

Ability Commerce has officially released Ability Financials Release 10.0. In addition to making Ability Financials 10.0 fully compatible with Microsoft Dynamics™ GP Release 10.0, Ability Commerce added seven customer-requested enhancements. These enhancements improve integration between accounting software and order management systems.

A new feature, called vendor mapping, has been added that allows translation of a Vendor ID from an order management system, such as Ecometry from Escalate Retail, with a different Vendor ID used in Microsoft Dynamics GP. A “vendor create” window feature was added to support the Vendor ID numbering scheme.

The new release also allows merchants to map general ledger account numbers from multiple criteria and utilizes 12 fields of the standard Ecometry GL Extract during the mapping process. Previous releases only allowed 5 fields.

Additionally, general ledger accounts can now be created with an “account create” window, rather than the former manual creation process. Additional enhancements were added to improve interaction between Ability Financials and Ecometry Open Systems data.

The new enhancements will allow Ability Financials users to fully integrate Microsoft Dynamics GP accounting and financial software with their order management systems.
